What this page is for: Make unresolved questions a stop condition.

Worksheet excerpt cards

Row 1: Planning reference, not electrical code

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 2: Final values must be verified against exact components

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 3: Do not energize a circuit with unresolved questions

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

How to use it: This product is intentionally cautious because wire, fuse, and breaker decisions are safety-critical.

Sample 2: Circuit planner

What this page is for: Force every circuit to name its source.

Representative worksheet excerpt:

Row 1: Source, load, voltage, expected amps, max amps

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 2: Wire candidate, fuse/breaker candidate, disconnect needed

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 3: Manual reference, open question, final verified by

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

How to use it: The point is not guessing values faster. It is making the verification trail visible.

Sample 3: Manual/source log

What this page is for: Stop losing the manual page that justified the decision.

Representative worksheet excerpt:

Worksheet excerpt cards

Row 1: Component model, decision being verified, source type

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 2: Manual page, manufacturer URL, value found

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 3: Confidence, unresolved question, support ticket

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

How to use it: Especially useful when quotes, manuals, and forum advice start blending together.

Sample 4: Status board

What this page is for: Keep unresolved circuits visibly yellow or red.

Representative worksheet excerpt:

Row 1: Circuit, work type, current status

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 2: Current gate and allowed next step

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 3: Do-not-energize condition and final verifier

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

How to use it: The safest output is sometimes a red row that names the exact qualified-review question.

Sample 5: Decision gates

What this page is for: Separate shopping from installing and energizing.

Representative worksheet excerpt:

Worksheet excerpt cards

Row 1: Planning / quote gate

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 2: Buy-final-parts gate

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 3: Install and energize gates

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

How to use it: A circuit can be useful for quote review and still be yellow or red for install day.

Sample 6: Panel label template

What this page is for: Make the finished electrical bay readable later.

Representative worksheet excerpt:

Worksheet excerpt cards

Row 1: Circuit label, protected by, normal load

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 2: Do not run with, shutoff location

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

Row 3: Manual/source and notes

Why it matters: Keeps the source, open question, and final verifier visible before the circuit moves forward.

How to use it: This is the serviceability piece that pays off months after the install.

What The Full Planning File Helps You Produce

- Clearer wire, fuse, breaker, disconnect, and label notes
- Cleaner conversations with installers and manufacturers
- A source trail before a circuit is energized
- A gate check before final parts are purchased or installed
- A readable panel label set for future troubleshooting
